



The Chain of Love Foundation for Turner Syndrome was established in 2004 with the mission to support medical research and increase public awareness of Turner Syndrome. The Foundation promotes early detection, fosters healthy management of symptoms, and strives to **increase the quality of life** for those touched by Turner Syndrome. The Chain of Love Foundation provides funding to ongoing, innovative research, educational programming, and grants to charitable activities for children and families impacted by Turner Syndrome.

With this mission in mind, The Chain of Love Foundation is offering a scholarship for a young woman, aged 12 to 19, to attend Turner Syndrome Camp, a summer program hosting 50 teens from all parts of the United States and Canada. Turner Syndrome Camp, located at Pepperdine University in Malibu, California, **integrates educational, motivational, and creational activities**. The scholarship is for families who have financial need demonstrated by providing a current year tax return which shows an annual income of \$50,000 or less. This number is increased by \$10,000 for each dependent. For example, a family with three dependents qualifies for the scholarship if their annual income is \$80,000 or less.

At the Turner Syndrome Camp at Pepperdine University, **the teens create a supportive community in which new relationships can develop and thrive**. This summer program, sponsored by the Children's Hospital of Los Angeles, offers activities including: team building games; theatre and art workshops; a beach party; a tour of the Getty Museum; evening excursions to unique venues in Los Angeles; a "Salon" with a team of hairstylists from Vidal Sassoon Academy; individualized nutrition counseling; gourmet cooking classes; and presentations by Dr. Mitchell Geffner.
