

Friends of East Goshen Township



The Friends of East Goshen Township provides support for the preservation and improvement of township parks, recreation facilities, open space, historical structures and activities that improve the quality of life for township residents and the community at large.

East Goshen Township was originally a part of a 5000-acre parcel of land known as the "Welsh Tract" and purchased from William Penn September 16, 1681. Early settlers conveyed the name Goshenville on the area but Goshen Township became the formally established

municipality in 1704 encompassing West Chester and East and West Goshen Townships. Goshen Township was reduced in size with the incorporation of West Chester Borough in 1788 and the remaining Township was further divided into East Goshen and West Goshen Townships in 1817. Today, East Goshen Township comprises 10.1 square miles in area and is home to more than 16,000 persons.

The Township has two large parks (55 acres and 100 acres), several neighborhood parks and over 200 acres of open space. The Township has an established trail network through the Township Park located on both sides of Paoli Pike and connecting to the Plank House and Blacksmith Shop along East Boot Road. Goshenville was designated a Historic District by the National Register of Historic Places in 2000.
