A blood study will be held to further Mesothelioma Research

Monday, July 27, 2009 ~ 3 PM - 7 PM

at Paoli Memorial Hospital Outpatient Lab

Asbestos is known to cause Mesothelioma and is being linked to other cancers according to the American Cancer Society.

Mesothelioma is a sheet-like tumor that covers the lining of the lung the lining of the heart or the lining of the abdomen.

Although this cancer remains to be rare, 2,000 to 3,000 new cases of the disease are diagnosed in the United States each year.

No cost to participate in this blood study.

Participants of this study answer YES to ONE or MORE of the following:

- 1) I have been exposed to asbestos
- 2) I have lived & or worked with or around someone exposed to asbestos
- 3) I am related to someone who has been exposed to asbestos

The research team of Joseph Testa, PhD, Fox Chase Cancer Center continues this blood test study to gain FDA approval for initial diagnosis of mesothelioma. Early diagnosis may result in a cure.
